

Leadership Cayuga Projects

Leadership Cayuga participants must undertake projects that address a community need; an idea or initiative that might otherwise not be addressed. Throughout the process, they experience teamwork in action, including the critical roles of leaders and followers.

The Leadership Cayuga Class of 2012 project teams will each select a community based project at their Opening Retreat in January to complete by early May.

Goals:

- Experience group process and teamwork in action, including the roles of leaders and follower
- Have the opportunity to take a leadership role in the group
- Gain research and presentation skills
- Affect a community challenge through group effort
- Foster the belief that community needs can be addressed by working together as a group

Criteria:

Does the project directly deal with an issue that affects the economic or social climate of Cayuga County?

Will the project have an impact on the issue?

Does the project reflect the Leadership Cayuga curriculum?

Will the project reflect positively on the Leadership Cayuga Program?

Does the project have the potential to demonstrate leadership?
